We are especially hoping to support those from disadvantaged and challenging backgrounds. The award will be a mix of both mentoring with an established writer based in Cornwall (face-to-face sessions supported by email contact) and a cash award of up to £1,000 (which will be paid after discussion with your mentor) with a reading award of £150 worth of books. The mentoring support is offered for a period of up to a year.

The deadline for applications is 31st July 2023 with awards made in September 2023.
